Amendment to Blacktown City Council's submission to the NSW Productivity Commission's issues paper – Review of Infrastructure Contributions in New South Wales.

I refer to Council's submission to the NSW Productivity Commission's issues paper – Review of Infrastructure Contributions in New South Wales provided on 5 August 2020.

At its Ordinary meeting on 28 October 2020, Council resolved that:

Item 2, page 8 of its submission be amended to further clarify how a reduced timeframe for contribution plan reviews can be achieved, being that provided the increase in land values is no greater than the actual movements experienced by Council over the review period, then the review time taken by both IPART and the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment combined should not exceed 6 months.

I appreciate that submissions have now closed. However, Council would appreciate if this clarification to our submission could be included in the Commissioner's consideration of its submission.
